Program Overview

The Fresno Internship Credential Program (FICP) is an internship program for individuals seeking to obtain their Preliminary Teaching Credential while teaching as the teacher of record in their own classroom. The FICP is fully accredited and upon completion, individuals will be recommended to the California Commission on Teacher Credentialing for a Preliminary Teaching Credential in their area of coursework.

Program Supports:

- Cohort model
- One course at time, 2 evenings a week
- Support from on-site mentors and knowledgeable supervisors
- Highly qualified instructors
- Collaboration between all stakeholders
- Support with teacher assessments (TPA, RICA)

Financial Support

Intern teachers will have a portion of their salary pay for the credential program over the course of two years.
