TUBERCULOSIS TESTS

PERMANENT EMPLOYEES:

Permanent employees must have a current tuberculosis (TB) test on file at all times. The California Education Code mandates that permanent employees have a TB test every four years. As of January 2016, if an employee has previously shown a positive skin test, the employee must provide a copy of his/her chest x-ray result to Human Resources. No questionnaire will be needed after the chest x-ray is provided.

FUSD will cover the cost of the TB test for permanent employees of the District providing the test is administered at the Fresno Unified Student Health Center. Employees may also use the services of their private physician, if they prefer; however, the initial cost is the employee's responsibility.

SUBSTITUTE/STUDENT EMPLOYEES:

Temporary employees must have a current TB test on file at all times. The California Education Code mandates that employees of a school district have a tuberculosis test every four years. If an employee has previously shown a positive skin test, a questionnaire will be provided and must be completed by a licensed physician or by the Fresno Unified Student Health Center in lieu of the skin test.

It is the responsibility of the temporary employee to cover the cost of the tuberculosis skin test.
