- B. Provide each student with materials necessary for independent travel
- C. Maintain appropriate records of each individual's progress in the program
- D. Participate in assessment, placement, program planning, written instructional plans, re-evaluations when appropriate as a member of the School Appraisal Team
- E. Work in conjunction with other teachers of physically handicapped to counsel parents in regard to social adjustment, school progress, and orientation and mobility
- F. Maintain a close liaison with community agencies concerned with the physically handicapped
