Assist Coordinator of GATE program by furnishing information for the purposes of reapplication to the State Department of Education Special Programs Division
Assist in providing in-service to coordinators, principals and citizens of the Fresno Unified School District school community
Assist in providing information for GATE teachers regarding current trends in the Gifted And Talented Education
